Task 1: Field Investigations (\$33,000)

Task 1a: Source Identification Advanced Investigations (\$27,000)

WQMD will work with ARC staff, the City of Plymouth and the Wayne County Roads Division to arrange for and/or perform investigative monitoring of manholes, dye testing, smoke testing or closed-circuit televise (CCTV) inspections as described in Table 1 to specifically locate sanitary sewer connections into the Harvey Street and Park Street municipal separate storm sewer systems (MS4).

Task 1b: Field Screening Priority Areas (\$6,000)

WQMD will procure lab services and collect samples at up to 18 - 25 sites within the ARC's Collaborative IDEP Priority Areas once in 2016 during dry weather conditions. The purpose of the sampling is to help further isolate/refine source identification priority areas for future collaborative IDEP Advanced Investigations. *Escherichia coli* (*E. coli*) analysis will be performed on the water samples collected. Table 2 and Figure 1 (below) identifies the sites that WQMD will target for sample collection. Several additional sites may be added based on results at these sites or in response to ARC staff/ARC member requests.

Task : Reporting (\$2,000)

Progress summaries will be written for each quarterly invoice. A written and oral summary of activities and results will be provided at ARC Technical Committees and a comprehensive final report will be prepared for use in the ARC's Annual Report.

Total Work Plan Budget: \$35,000 (\$27,500 ARC funds; \$7,500 WCDPS match)
